Driving impact

- Our data on the impact of [severe abortion restrictions in Texas](#) have been cited in court challenges, widely covered in the media, and presented in expert witness testimony by Ibis VP Dr. Daniel Grossman.
- Ibis research informed the [Access to Contraception for Women Servicemembers and Dependents Act](#), introduced in the US Senate and House.
- Our work helped to get [mifepristone onto South Africa's Essential Medicines List](#) for first- and second-trimester abortion.
- We are leading the charge to [move an oral contraceptive pill over the counter in the US](#) and harnessing current political and public interest to ensure widespread access to a future over-the-counter pill.
- Our evaluation of [telemedicine provision of medication abortion](#) has been critical in ongoing litigation to appeal the Iowa Board of Medicine ruling to outlaw the practice.
